- Resolutions that are passed at the Congressional District Convention will then be forwarded to the 2024 State Convention where they are voted on; where once again a simple majority is required to pass.
- Resolutions that are passed at the 2024 State Convention are incorporated into the Standing Platform of the Republican Party of Minnesota.
